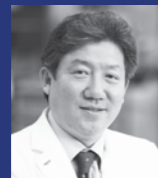
As the first international scientific meeting in the field of laboratory medicine in the Asian region, LMCE 2016 is expected to gather over 1,000 participants from all over the world.
